

A brief history of commemorative coin 'The Three Royal Patrons'

The commemorative coin 'The Three Royal Patrons' was produced as a means of fundraising for the new outpatient building, 'Phor Por Ror', in commemoration of His Majesty, the late King Bhumibol's 60th birthday in 1987, as well as celebrating the 72nd Anniversary of King Chulalongkorn Memorial Hospital, Thai Red Cross Society. Her Royal Highness Princess Mahachakri Sirindhorn was the head supervisor of the construction, along with His Supreme Patriarch, the late Somdet Phra Nyanasamvara Somdet Phra Sangharaj, representing the religious sector.
